- Administered via web-based surveys, in-depth interviews (face-to-face and telephone) or focus groups tailored to an organization's needs and budget
- Designed to collect valid and reliable data in accordance with best practice evaluation standards
- Customized to meet the specific emergency preparedness needs of each client

YNH-CEPDR can help determine how prepared your organization is to respond to a disaster by:

- Ensuring plans are fully compliant with national standards (e.g., The Joint Commission, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), National Fire Protection Administration and Occupational Safety and Health Administration)
- Conducting emergency operations plan/emergency management plan gap and compliance analyses
- Assisting with preparation for The Joint Commission accreditation surveys, HHS, DHS, CMS, NIAHO and other standard setting and regulatory organizations
